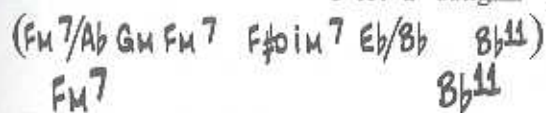

Since you and I have



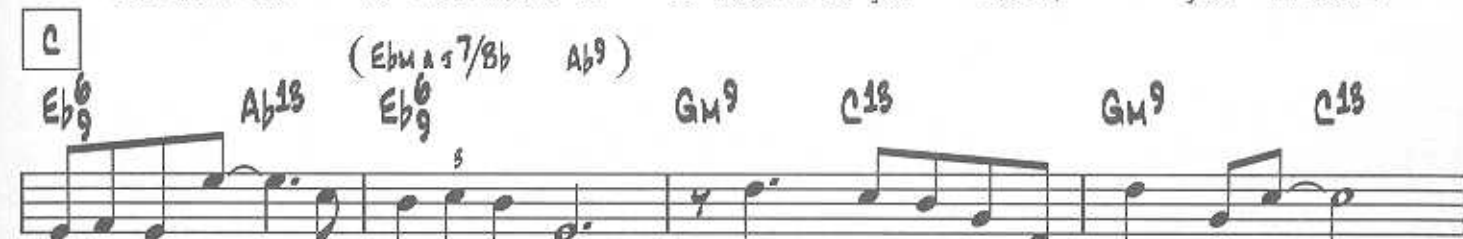
drift-ed a-part, life does-n't mean a thing to me. Please come back, sweet mu-sic, I
